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Vision of the Department:

To deliver quality, equitable, affordable effective primary health care which is accessible to all emphasizing on health of the child, pregnant women and elderly.

Objective of the Department:

- To prevent, control and manage communicable, non-communicable and life style diseases.
- To have effective disaster management plans.
- To promote healthy and pollution free environment.
- Nurturing a mind set among the public to identify health needs and utilize health services.
- To achieve population stabilization, gender and demographic balance.
- To prevent and promote health care in addition to the routine curative services and rehabilitation aspects of health care.
- Sustain the achievements by integrated disease surveillance as a core interventional tool.
- To promote maternal and child health services in order to reduce maternal and infant mortality.
- To promote AYUSH services and integrate AYUSH services in Primary Health Care.
- To extend Dental health services and Geriatric care at Primary Health Care level.

Short Term Goals (2021)

- Sustain the Maternal deaths to negligible level and IMR to less than 6.
- Elimination of Malaria & Filariasis by 2021.
- Identify and Manage of Latent TB Infections.
- Ensure better coverage of screening and testing facilities for HIV.
- Ensuring Universal Health coverage and Universal access to sexual and reproductive health care services with national strategy.
- Reducing the prevalence of blindness and disease burden of blindness & visual impairment.
- Ensuring comprehensive coverage under Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY) scheme across the state.
- To provide cost effective and equitable AYUSH health care throughout the State.
- Reduction of morbidity and mortality due to Non-Communicable Diseases like Diabetes, hypertension, cardiovascular disease and cancers.

Medium Term Goals (2023)

- To reduce disability due to Communicable or Non-Communicable Disease by early detection, prompt intervention and rehabilitation.
- Reduce new HIV infection by 80%.
- To achieve 100% Institutional deliveries.
- To achieve 100% full immunisation along with introduction of Pneumococcal Conjugate vaccine in children between 9-11 months.
- Implementation of WHO framework convention on tobacco control.
- Implementation of Ayushman Bharat School Health & Wellness Ambassador initiative.
- Strengthening National Mental Health Programme services.
- National Quality Assurance Standards (NQAS) certification of all District Hospitals/ Community Health Centres.
- Up scaling the digital platform to provide health care services including mental health and laboratory services.
- To ensure that every family is covered under Deen Dayal Swasthya Seva Yojana (DDSSY) Scheme and also to ensure that full benefit is taken by the beneficiaries.

Long Term Goals (2025)

- Sustain the gain achieved in Malaria & Filariasis elimination.
- National Quality Assurance Standards (NQAS) certification of Primary Health Centres.
- To revitalize and strengthen the AYUSH systems making them as prominent medical streams in addressing the health care of the society and thereby having a separate AYUSH department.
- To end the spread of drug-susceptible and drug resistant tuberculosis by achieving universal access to prevention, diagnosis and treatment.
- End epidemic of AIDS, Tuberculosis, Malaria and neglected tropical diseases and combat hepatitis, water borne disease and other communicable diseases.
- To have more specialized doctors in the state at District Hospitals and Community Health Centres.
- To reduce stigma and discrimination of leprosy patients, sustain no deformity cases; sustain PR < 0.7 per 10,000 population and Treatment Completion Rate to be sustained at 100%.
- Increase the number of empanelled hospitals in order to ease the access of PMJAY services.

Strategies

- Ensuring atleast 4 antenatal visits and identify antenatal risk factors for early referrals.
- LAQSHYA certification of all District & Sub-District Hospitals including Goa Medical College.
- Early detection by Surveillance and Case Management alongwith Integrated Vector Management.
- Identification and treatment of Latent Tuberculosis Infection (LTI) among contacts of Tuberculosis patients.
- Outreach Camps at all levels in the health care delivery system for early screening and detection of diseases.
- Health promotion through Behaviour Change by massive Health Education with involvement of Community, Civil Society, Community based organizations and media.
- Development of database of diseases through a Robust Surveillance System and to monitor morbidity, mortality and risk factors.
- Build capacity at various levels of health care for prevention, early diagnosis, treatment, operational research by training programme.
- Collaboration with Goa Dental College and other stakeholders like Police Department, Panchayat, FDA, Civil Society for measures to reduce tobacco addiction.

Action Plan

- Ayushman Bharat-Health & Wellness Centres upto sub-centre level along with AYUSH Health & Wellness Centre will be set-up at all peripheral health centres.
- Setting-up of two 50 Bedded Integrated AYUSH Hospitals.
- Increasing number of Spoke centres under STEMI programme to reduce mortality due to Myocardial Infarction.
- Satellite Centres will be set-up in coordination with Goa Dental College for upgradation of Dental services at Primary Health Care level and having speciality dental services at District Hospitals.
- Special Case detection activities, awareness generation (IEC) on leprosy and Post exposure prophylaxis with single dose, Rifampicin of contacts of newly detected cases.
- Setting-up of Tele –Consultation with E-Sanjeevani at Primary Health Care level including Mental Health.
- Establishing Laboratory Information Management System (LIMS) at District Hospitals.
- Setting-up of Viral Hepatitis programme at Goa Medical College & both District Hospitals to cater to large number of patients.
- Setting-up of Virology Laboratory at North Goa District Hospital.
- Inclusion of beneficiaries from 0-18 years for Anaemia Mukta Bharat by distribution of Iron folic Acid at all level.
- Setting up of Addiction Treatment Facility (ATF) to tackle alcoholism and smoking and substance abuse.
- Autism & behavior disorder management will be catered at both District Early Intervention Centre (DEIC).

- Echo Cardio & Stress test facility at District Hospitals to tackle early detection of Cardiac complication and referral.
- DNB courses will be started at North Goa District Hospital.
- Scrutiny of the areas with more number of PMJAY beneficiaries and create awareness to enhance the beneficiaries availing the services under the scheme.
- Setting up of Line Probe Assay (LPA) laboratory at IRL laboratory in Goa Medical College.
- Nucleic Acid Amplification Tests (NAAT) will be offered to all Presumptive cases of Tuberculosis.
- Setting-up of State of the Art 3D Printing Workshop for Custom made Orthotics and Braces for children attending DEIC in South Goa.
- Total coverage of all Educational Institutions through establishment of additional Red Ribbon Clubs.
